What can I expect at Summer Reading Club?

This year, we will have five sessions in which we “travel” to different destinations in Mary Pope Osborne’s “Magic Tree House” series! Summer Reading Club includes a variety of in-house programming and outside educators/entertainers. We will often break up into age-appropriate groups and do a variety of crafts, activities, and challenges. Throughout the program, we encourage good summer reading habits and work to increase comfort with and awareness of resources at Odell.

What if my child can't attend every session?

No problem! We know summer schedules can get busy. Attend the sessions you can and encourage kids to turn in their reading logs each week even if they can't attend the program.

How do you track my child's reading over the summer?

Participants are asked to track both the number of minutes read and the number of books read each week during summer reading club. Slips are available at the front desk and on Odell's website. Children receive special reader rewards for tracking their reading which helps keep the kids motivated!

My child isn't reading yet. Can they still participate?

Yes! Summer Reading Club is for pre-readers and readers alike! We want to encourage literacy at ALL ages. When you fill out a reading log, simply track the # of books/minutes they are read to.
