### **TIPS FOR CREATING A MASTERPIECE**

- Prepare a place to work. Make sure there is plenty of light. Organize your materials.
- Create a concept. What are you going to create? What are you trying to express?
- Sketch your design using a sharp pencil.
- Check your composition. While art has no rules, there are some principles that can make your masterpiece a little more pleasing. Is your composition balanced? What/ where is your focal point? Is there movement? Unity?
- Think about color. Remember, there are 3 primary colors (red, blue, yellow). Combinations of primary colors produce secondary colors (orange, green, violet). Adding white brightens; black deepens the shade. Have fun experimenting!
- Enjoy! Stay determined. Be patient. Keep creating!
