
NOVEMBER 2025 BOOK & BAKE SUCCESS

MICROGREENS

The Microgreens Workshops, led by Joyce Lewis (below) of the Ogle County Health Department, were a tremendous success. Thanks to a grant secured from the CDC, each participant received a passive hydroponics kit to grow microgreens at home. Odell will continue to grow microgreens over the next year to share with the community. More information to come.







The grant aims to educate communities on the health benefits or growing and using microgreens. A $\frac{3}{4}$ cup serving of microgreens has the equivalent nutritional value of 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ cups of raw veggies, the daily recommended amount.
