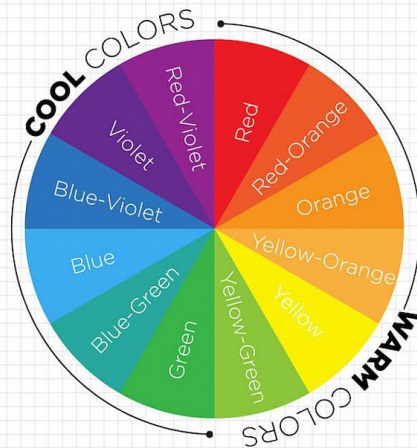

### Tips for Creating a Masterpiece

- Prepare a place to work. Make sure there is plenty of light. Organize your materials.
- Create a concept. What are you going to create? What are you trying to express?
- Sketch your design using a sharp pencil.
- Check your composition. While art has no rules, there are some principles that can make your masterpiece a little more pleasing. Is your composition balanced? What/where is your focal point? Is there movement? Unity?
- Think about color. Remember, there are 3 primary colors (red, blue, yellow). Combinations of primary colors produce secondary colors (orange, green, violet). Consult the color wheel and mixing guide for more guidance. Have fun experimenting!
- Stay determined. Be patient. Keep creating!

### COLOR WHEEL



**RED + YELLOW = ORANGE**

**BLUE + YELLOW = GREEN**

**RED + BLUE = PURPLE**

**RED + WHITE = PINK**

**BLACK + WHITE = GRAY**

**WHITE + COLOR = LIGHTER\***

**BLACK + COLOR = DARKER\***

\*If you want to darken a light color, only a small amount of dark color is needed. The opposite is true for lightening colors. To lighten a color, you will need a good amount of white.
