Artists of all ages and abilities are invited to pick up a Tiny Art Kit, containing a 4"x4" canvas, acrylic paints, brush, and instructions beginning Monday, February 10th. Tiny masterpieces should be returned to Odell by Saturday, March 1st to be displayed in the Tiny Art Show running March 3rd-29th. A selection of artwork will then be showcased uptown at the Loft on Main throughout April. Our inaugural Tiny Art Show took place in Spring 2022 and featured over 350 artworks. This free project is for anyone in the community. We believe that EVERYONE IS AN ARTIST. Not a painter? All mediums and materials welcome -- just keep it tiny! Your art will be featured at Odell in a Tiny Art Show throughout the month of March. A portion of Tiny Art will then move to Morrison's own art gallery: the Loft on Main! TIPS FOR CREATING A MASTERPIECE

- Prepare a place to work. Make sure there is plenty of light. Organize your materials.
- Create a concept. What are you going to create? What are you trying to express?
- Sketch your design using a sharp pencil.
- Check your composition. While art has no rules, there are some principles that can make your masterpiece a little more pleasing. Is your composition balanced? What/ where is your focal point? Is there movement? Unity?
- Think about color. Remember, there are 3 primary colors (red, blue, yellow). Combinations of primary colors produce secondary colors (orange, green, violet). Adding white brightens; black deepens the shade. Have fun experimenting!
- Enjoy! Stay determined. Be patient.






